The Selection Committee convenes after the June 1 deadline to determine the minimum GPA and number of points needed for Program admission.

Students that are completing courses over the summer who meet the requirements will be sent a conditional acceptance letter. Acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of the courses being taken while maintaining the GPA/points determined by the Committee. The student must request, from the institution where the courses are completed, that official transcripts be sent to the Central Campus upon completion of the courses. If selected for the Program and the official transcripts are not on file the student will be unable to enter the Program due to proof of required courses not being met.

****After Summer semester 2010, students will not be allowed to complete courses over the summer semester and still make application for June 1 of that year. All pre-requisite courses, volunteer hours and evaluation forms will all need to be completed by the June 1 deadline and submitted with the PTA application.***

Students not completing the pre-requisite courses at Bishop State Community College will be responsible for making sure all official transcripts are on file at the Central Campus by the June 1 deadline.
